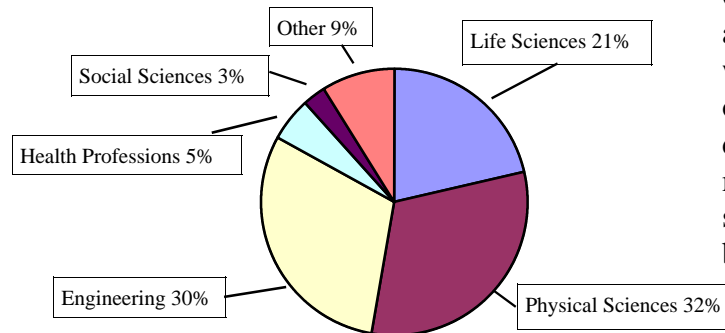
NOGLSTP's goals include:

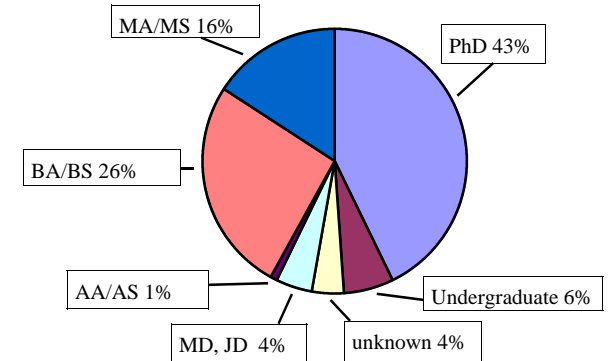
Profession Categories Represented by NOGLSTP Members

- ⇒ Established in 1980 as National Organization of Lesbian and Gay Scientists, reorganized in 1983 as National Organization of Gay and Lesbian Scientists and Technical Professionals, incorporated in the State of California 1991, granted IRS 501(c)3 non-profit status 1993, Tax ID Number 95-4358685
- ⇒ Affiliate of American Association for Advancement of Science since 1994; involved with the AAAS Section on Societal Impacts of Science and Engineering
- ⇒ Annual dues: \$25-\$40, sliding scale; \$20 for Post-Docs; \$10 for students and retired/unemployed
